Guide Sheet for Students Transferring from JCC to SHU

Students considering education should plan on taking only general education courses at JCC and should contact Sara Johnson at 517-264-7185 immediately for guidance on which classes they should take. Additional classes may be taken depending on which major and/or minor the student is pursuing. **Students should NOT pursue an Associate's Degree.**

Since teacher education is not a major or minor, students select an academic major and minor from the list of Teacher Certification Approved Program Areas. In addition to choosing one major and one minor from the choices below, students also complete Teacher Education Course Requirements (see 2006-2008 catalog, page 39), and meet Liberal Arts Studies requirements (see catalog, pages 10-12), and additional degree requirements (see catalog, pages 17-18).
