### Add a Management Minor to Your Degree!

The Siena Heights University Management minor is offered for students who would like to complement their major programs (often Multidisciplinary Studies or Bachelor of Applied Science programs) with coursework that will lend a specialization to their degree. Specifically, students pursuing the Management minor can gain knowledge in such fields as leadership, labor relations, teamwork and entrepreneurship. The Management minor is a total of 21 semester hours (see below) requiring a 12 semester hours residency at the 300/400 level at Siena Heights University. Business majors may not complete a Management minor.
