


CREATING A USER PROFILE


When you create a user profile, you must know the **Class ID Number** and the **Class Enrollment Password**. This information can be obtained from your course instructor.

- † Open your Web Browser.
- † In the **Address** box, input www.turnitin.com.
- † Press the **Enter** key.
- or
- † Log into **My Siena**.
- † Scroll to the **Quick Links** portal.
- † Click the **Turnitin** link.
- † To create a new account:
- † Click the **New Users** link (see illustration below).


- † The **New User** page will open.
