

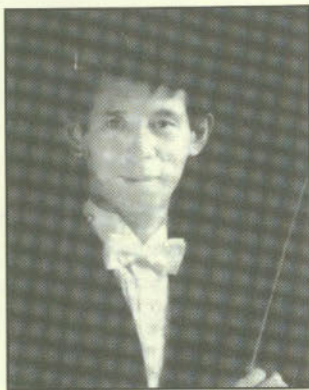

Jacob Chi '85 Continues Making Music at Miami University

They say "howdy" instead of "hello" and life moves a whole lot slower, says Jacob Chi '85 of his last two years in Pueblo,



Colorado, where he conducted the Pueblo Symphony Orchestra and was artist in residence at the University of Southern Colorado.

In August Chi took a new post at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, where he is a tenured Assistant Professor in Music and

conductor of the University's Orchestra. Chi was well-known in Pueblo for his intriguing ideas that helped to bolster the Symphony's audience. A review in the local newspaper applauded him for his antics, some of which included wearing bumblebee antennae for *Flight of the Bumblebees* and coming in costume during a Halloween concert. He was credited for bringing a renewed interest in the Orchestra, and was well-liked by students.

"He is beloved," said his wife Lin Chang, who also attended Siena Heights for a short time in the graduate program. "He will be missed by all of the people." Chi's career at Siena Heights included obtaining a bachelor's degree in music. He played violin with the Adrian Symphony Orchestra and conducted the Lenawee County

Youth Symphony at Siena Heights. Having received a Master's degree from the University of Michigan and Michigan State University, Chi is very appreciative of the small college campus. "I enjoyed Siena Heights because it was small," Chi said. "For a student from overseas, the small college is important. It forces them to learn English quickly - at a larger university, you can find people who speak your language, and get away without speaking a lot of English," he added.

Chi was recruited to the College by former President Lou Vaccaro after playing violin for Vaccaro as he visited his family in China to recruit his two aunts who received master's degrees from the College. Jacob's brother also came to the United States and graduated from the University of Michigan.

Wellness Center Receives National Recognition

The Wellness Center at Siena Heights College is on the cutting edge of substance abuse prevention, says U.S. Department of Education evaluators. In recognition of Siena Heights' leadership in this area, the nationally prestigious **Fund for the Improvement of Postsecondary Education** has awarded the College a two-year grant to establish a drug abuse prevention model which can be successfully replicated at other higher institutions in the country. "It is a model which is focused on

solution, not problem, and fosters attention to healthy life styles and building community through participation and service," states Bernadette A. Pelland, Director of Counseling, Associate Dean of Students, and co-author of the grant. Pelland will direct the program with Jean Hornung-Starr as Program Coordinator. Both will work with the Wellness Committee and interested faculty, staff, and students in accomplishing program objectives.

"Creating partnerships with local educational and business organizations, joining efforts on reducing substance abuse, enhancing wellness, and involving participants in community service are key elements of the program," stated Pelland.

The Wellness Center was opened in January 1992 in the former resident director's apartment in Ledwidge Hall. There are five components to the Center:

Counseling/Consultation to provide assistance in managing change; Service Learning to facilitate volunteer community service; Peer Listeners/Peer Educators to equip volunteers with problem solving skills and supportive strategies; "Peacespace" to provide a quiet place for reflection and for learning spiritual practices; and Learning Circles for small groups to focus on critical personal, social, and political issues.

The Valiant Woman: Sister Ann Joachim, O.P. '31 (1901 - 1981)

Aviator, sportswoman, lawyer, educator, writer, and lecturer, Sister Ann Joachim was an Adrian Dominican woman of tremendous spirit and drive, ahead of her time in many ways and deeply devoted to her family, her Dominican sisters and Siena Heights College.

Born Petronilla M. Joachim in Cologne, Germany, on October 15, 1901, she emigrated to Detroit with her parents and siblings.

At fourteen Petronilla entered business college and began working as a stenographer for an attorney. Without a high school diploma she could not enter law school, so she began her studies, earning her diploma in less than two years. In 1920, before a college degree was needed to enter law school, Petronilla became the only woman freshman at the Detroit College of Law. She was highly incensed to be informed that women attended law school only long enough to find a husband!

Three momentous events marked her twenty-first birthday: she came of voting age, was certified as a notary public, and she graduated from law school. She passed the bar exam (she was the only woman present), and continued to work in the law office of Joseph L. Ruby, who later made her a partner. She remained there until she entered the convent at Adrian.

Awaiting results of the bar exam, Petronilla confided to a sister friend that she wanted to become a nun. She was told she was looking for an escape in case she didn't pass the bar, and that she could help others in her new profession. Practicing in various courts, she continued her studies and earned her Master's Degree from the University of Detroit School of Law in 1924. Again she spoke of entering the

convent, but she met disapproval from her family and friends. Even the Dominican sisters discouraged her when she visited the Motherhouse, though they asked her to represent them on certain legal matters. Finally, bargaining with St. Jude that if she won a particularly difficult case it would be a sign that she was to enter the Dominican Order, she won the case and kept the bargain, entering the novitiate in Adrian in January 1928. From St. Joseph's College (now Siena Heights College) she received a Bachelor of Arts degree.



Continuing her education, she earned a Master of Arts degree from Loyola University, Chicago, and a Doctor of Philosophy in history degree from the International Catholic University of Fribourg, Switzerland. On her return from Europe she was invited to stop in Washington, D.C., where she was admitted to practice law before the United State Supreme Court, the first woman religious to receive such a distinction.

She returned to Siena Heights, where she was named chairperson of the history department. She was fondly known as A.J. by the many students who sat in her classes and took her

orally administered tests during which she never repeated a statement. "If you don't hear it the first time, there's no second chance!" Students were often invited as her guests at political meetings and service club dinners, encouraging them to become involved in political matters and community projects. In 1971 Sister Ann Joachim became an Adrian City Commissioner. In 1972 the United Transportation Union made her an honorary member of Local 1438 and gave her a plaque for her efforts in saving the Wabash Cannonball. Earlier distinctions included lifetime membership in the Lenawee County Bar Association; University of Detroit "Woman of the Year"; listing in 2000 Women of the World of Achievement (London, England); lecturing in more than 165 locations to women lawyers in the USSR--the first woman in religious garb admitted to the USSR since 1917.

Sister authored many articles, many of them dealing with private hospital law and charitable immunity. In 1939 she wrote an article in which she stated, "It is an old fashioned view nowadays to protest against so many working women. It is old fashioned because they must work to live and because employers want them to work, and because their work is needed." She concluded, "The problem of women in industry will never be solved until the general labor problem is solved." In 1952 she wrote "Women in the Atomic Age," stating, "To fill her place in public life, a woman needs education . . . With education comes leadership."

Sister Ann Joachim was an accomplished, hard-working, intelligent, compassionate and basically humble individual, truly an outstanding woman of her time, ahead of her time, and for all time.

Magical Moments - Celebrating 30 Years of Dreams Coming True

The drama program at Siena Heights began 30 years ago under the inspiration of a nun called Sister Therese Craig. Today that program continues to flourish under the direction of Trudy McSorley, Director of the Children's Drama Program since 1973.

According to McSorley, the program began when Sr. Therese introduced dramatic improvisation to her Teaching Creative Drama class at the College - a class which McSorley was in. "Therese's idea was that you couldn't teach something like this without applying it to kids," McSorley explained. "Children were brought to campus to do creative drama." McSorley said the class -- and the program -- "touched me somewhere down deep" right from the start.

Every summer, McSorley labors to bring truth to young people. This means dealing with topics like drug abuse, divorce, death, health issues and relationships, in an improvisational format. "We constantly have

to ask ourselves what it is that concerns kids," she said. "We deal with some heavy stuff."

"I don't care if the students I teach ever do any theater work," McSorley said. "That's not really what's important here." What's important is that the "creative drama program allows young people to feel articulate, self confident, and most of all, valued as human beings."

The summer drama program is a place where no one will laugh at your thoughts, dreams or emotions. It is a place where children are accepted, loved, nurtured and encouraged to dramatic discoveries about themselves. "I've had students tell me they really didn't feel accepted for who and what they were in school -

- but in drama they feel OK. No one laughs at them or makes fun of their ideas," said McSorley. "I think that's a pretty neat thing. I hold that very deep in my heart." "This is not Trudy's program. It's not Siena Heights' program. It's everyone's program. It belongs to the community; it belongs to Siena Heights; it belongs to the parents;



and mostly, it belongs to the children."

Miriam Michael Stimson, O.P. '36, Professor Emerita of Chemistry, was selected as 1992/93 International Woman of the Year for her contributions to educational leadership in science by the International Biographical Centre of Cambridge, England.

Sharon Weber, O.P. '69, former Vicaress of the Adrian Dominican Congregation will return to Siena Heights to teach chemistry, and also returning is **Sister Nadine Foley, O.P.** '45, former Prioress of the Adrian Dominican Congregation, she will be teaching religious studies and philosophy.

The Management Division held a seminar entitled *Why does God Love Capitalists?* This was the second in a series of seminars designed around the theme that ideas matter, and the more important the idea, the more it matters.

The workshop, was part of the North Central Association's annual meeting. Mark chaired the self-study North Central committee for Siena from 1990 to 1992 and as a result of his work the College was re-accredited

by the North Central Association for the years 1992 - 2002.

Annita Cantu '77, Director of the Upward Bound Program, was chosen by the Zonta Club of Lenawee as a "Women Making History" in celebration of National Women's Month. Cantu helps guide minority and financially disadvantaged high school students toward higher education and a brighter future.

Saleem Peeradina, Assistant Professor of English, was invited to give several poetry readings last spring at places such as Ball State University, University of Michigan, Aquinas College, University of Iowa, and at the 11th Annual Colloquium Poetry Series at Wayne State University. His collection of poems, *Group Portrait*, was published in 1992 by Oxford University Press.

Dr. David Calonne, Associate Professor of English, presented his paper entitled *D.H. Lawrence and Modernism* at the Fifth Annual International D.H. Lawrence Conference held at the University of Ottawa, Canada, in June.

Sister Cathleen, the unanimous choice of the committee, was selected for her professional achievement, community involvement and leadership. Sister Cathleen was also awarded the Stubnitz Award by the Lenawee County United Way for her outstanding service and contribution to United Way. She has been a member of the United Way board for six years.

Anne Russell Mayeaux, Ph.D., Associate Professor of Philosophy, was named to an international delegation of scholars who spoke before the Russian Academy of Sciences and the Institute for the Study of Religion and Atheism in June. She also addressed the faculties at the St. Petersburg Theological Academy in St. Petersburg and scholars from the Departments of History and Museum Studies of Kiev T. G. Shevchenko University in Kiev on the topic of human rights.

Journey to Mexico

Following a period of preparation, ten Siena Heights College students, along with **Dom Scibilia**, Assistant Professor of Religious Studies and Co-Director of the Spirituality and Peacemaking Institute, traveled to Cuernavaca, Mexico in June.

The fifteen day journey began with a pilgrimage in Mexico City to the Basilica of the Virgin of Guadalupe. After arriving in Cuernavaca the group settled in and prepared themselves to spend the next fifteen days in unfamiliar territory. During the course of their Mexican adventure the group conversed with urban and rural squatters, artisans, community organizers working on labor rights, housing, and clean water concerns. The local farmers and environmentalists introduced the group to the ecological and political issues in agriculture from a food first mentality. Campesinos, sociologists and historians from the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM) and theologians engaged the Adrian entourage in the life and thought of Mexico. The group saw the story of the people of Mexico come alive in the murals and archeological sites that they visited. For the Siena Heights group the journey was a personal encounter with the power of the Mexican people as they work to fashion a just and peaceful society. Their learning experience was hosted and facilitated by the Cuernavaca Center for Intercultural Dialogue on Development (CCIDD). Unlike service programs that teach from a doing philosophy, CCIDD challenged the Adrian group to discover the dynamics of the people's struggle (La Lucha) for social justice. Listening and being are the proactive methods that form our seeing, prompt our thinking/judging and inform/motivate the students' actions when they returned to Adrian.

The journey for the Siena Heights students did not end when their plane lifted off from Mexico City. The process of social transformation became personal, both in their homes and workplaces, where they now work to make a just and peaceful history.

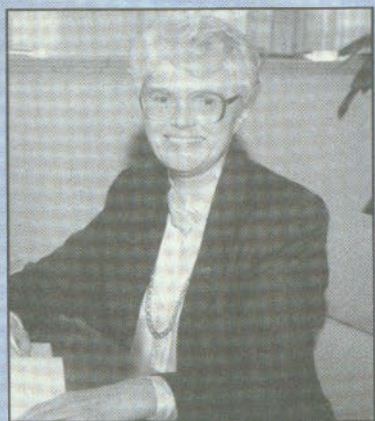


My Dear Friends,

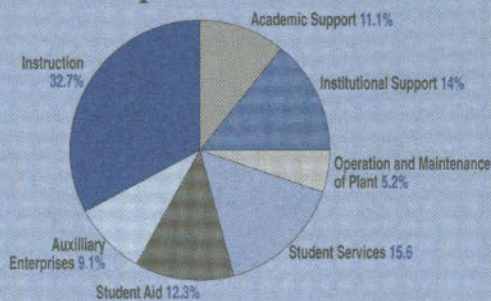

As Vice President for Advancement at Siena Heights Ferin will be responsible for fundraising, alumni relations, public relations, coordination of volunteers and internal resources in College fundraising and related advancement efforts.

College Creates Alumni Recognition Grants

Working closely with the Alumni Board, the College's administration has created an alumni recognition grant program. This program will provide a \$1,000 grant (\$500 a semester) to a son, daughter, or spouse of a graduate of Siena Heights College (any campus) who enrolls at the main campus on a full-time basis. The grant is renewable and is not need-based. The first awards will be available for the Fall, 1994 entering class. This grant may be combined with other federal, state and institutional awards for which the student may be eligible. It should be emphasized that this program is designed to highlight the College's commitment to making a Siena Heights education affordable to the families of our alumni.

Alumni Board Initiates Recruitment Program

On Sunday, July 25 the Board of Directors of the Siena Heights College Alumni Association met and agreed to initiate/develop a student recruitment program to assist the efforts of the Admissions Office of the College. Key features of this new program includes:

- development of a strong alumni referral program (relatives, neighbors, work colleagues)
- an involvement of alumni in college fairs/nights
- holding alumni receptions for prospective and admitted students in primary market areas
- alumni telemarketing assistance for selected prospective students
- identification of highly successful graduates for each of the college's programs to assist promotion
- creation of alumni recognition grants

Federal Grants

The College has been awarded five distinguished and intensively competitive grants from the federal government through the U.S. Department of Education, with awards totalling \$1,862,111 to be distributed over the next two to four years.

In its first year of a three-year award totalling \$390,000, the Ronald E. McNair Postbaccalaureate Achievement Program was granted through Title IV of the Higher Education Act. It is designed to prepare college juniors and seniors who are traditionally under-represented for success in graduate and professional schools. Siena Heights College is among eight higher educational institutions in the midwest to win this award. The others are University of Minnesota, University of Wisconsin - Milwaukee, University of Illinois - Champagne/Urbana, Michigan State University, Marquette University, Purdue University, and Notre Dame. The strength of Siena Heights' proposal came from the unique faculty mentoring component practiced at the College through senior thesis projects.

Winning in open competition since 1979, the Student Support Services Program was granted another four-year award (1993-1997) of \$634,380, also funded through Title IV of the Higher Education Act. The Student Support Services Program provides tutoring and counseling services to students who are low-income and/or first generation college students.

Funded for three years for a total award of \$698,682 and a companion program to Student Support Services, Upward Bound was funded again this year, celebrating twenty years of continuous funding. This program is designed to prepare high school students for success in postsecondary education.

The Fund for the Improvement of Postsecondary Education (FIPSE) is the most prestigious educational division of the U.S. Department of Education. Siena Heights was awarded a two-year grant of \$113,519 to establish a model for drug and alcohol abuse prevention. The strength of the proposal came from the unique and cutting edge approach of the College's Counseling Center. The Wellness Project will serve the entire Siena community - students, faculty, and staff - and will create a coalition among businesses and agencies throughout Lenawee County.

Through Title III of the Higher Education Act, the College received a small planning grant of \$25,530 to assist with efforts to prepare a new strategic plan. This award will enable the institution to involve more community members in the planning process and to gather relevant data about strengths, weaknesses, threats, and opportunities for the College. A skilled strategic planning facilitator and a research analyst will be engaged to facilitate the process and gather data. Activities include: an all-college workshop to gather input; a two-day retreat to examine the belief statements about the College; and define goals; action teams to design implementation strategies; and all-college forums to solicit feedback.

Povish was awarded the Siena Medal for his support of Siena Heights College and his leadership within the local Catholic diocese.

Siena Heights President Sister Cathleen Real conferred bachelor degrees upon 36 students at the Lake Michigan College/Siena Heights College commencement on May 9 in the Mendel Center at Lake Michigan College in Benton Harbor. Rev. Edward A. Malloy, President of the University of Notre Dame, delivered the Commencement address. A reception was held on May 8 to celebrate the 10th anniversary of the Siena Heights College program on the Lake Michigan College campus.

The exhibit features religious votive paintings which were made during the Mexican post colonial period between 1780 - 1910. Each painting expressively, yet naively, depicts Christian personages held in strict devotion for good health, hope, and eternal salvation. Retablos are oil paintings usually on tin, of a Christian deity or saint.

Ex-votos are votive paintings very similar to Retablos. The major difference is that while Retablos depict a deity or saint, the ex-votos are more personal, specific, and include more characters than are found in Retablos. In addition, unlike the retablos, ex-votos continue to be painted in very rural parts of Mexico.

Siena Heights Coaches Compete In Triathlon

A year ago, Siena Heights College Head Softball and Associate Head Men's Basketball coach Al Sandifer couldn't swim a lap in the Lenawee Christian Family Center pool. Now he's swimming close to a mile, biking fifteen and running five miles in about two hours.

In August of 1992, Sandifer and Assistant Coach Mike Quinn (an '84 grad and Assistant Director of Admissions at the College) began training for their first triathlon.

"We were tired of workout programs that lasted two weeks, so we decided to train for nine or ten months for a triathlon," said Sandifer. "Setting up a training routine that involved all three events and varying that schedule--along with the idea of looking forward to competing--made the workouts easier to stick with."

"The Sandifer/Quinn Typical Week of Triathlon Training"

Here's the training schedule the two followed semi-religiously for eight months in preparation for their first triathlon:

Sunday -- 15 mile bike + 5 mile run
Monday/Wednesday -- 5-7 mile run
Tuesday/Thursday -- 1 mile swim + 10-15 mile bike
Friday -- 3-5 mile run
Saturday -- 1 mile swim

Sandifer and Quinn have continued to maintain this schedule in preparation for their next triathlon.

Quinn, who is pursuing a graduate degree in educational leadership at Eastern Michigan University in addition to his duties in the admissions office and athletics, credits the "buddy system" approach to training for keeping both Al and him motivated during the dog days of training. "There are many days when one of us doesn't feel like working out, and those are the days when it helps to have a buddy to keep you motivated."

"Lunchtime is Training Time"

While most of us are deciding where to dine or what to have for lunch, Quinn and Sandifer are deciding whether to run five or seven miles or are enroute to the pool to do their endless number of laps.

"Training for the swim is probably the hardest," said Sandifer, "because swimming in the pool is nothing like swimming during the event, where you'll have bodies all

over and people swimming over the top of you."

Both agree that scheduling their 11:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. workouts around their already busy schedules has made them more organized and self-disciplined. "If you don't write it into your daily routine it becomes too easy to skip," said Quinn.

Sandifer was a four-year letterwinner on the Saint's basketball team from 1976-79 and Quinn played basketball and ran track while at Siena Heights College from 1980-84.

"Race Day Reflections"

The early morning jogs in the frigid, January mornings in Dubuque (where the Saints were competing in the National Catholic Basketball Tournament) and the seven-mile runs around the "Spielman Loop" on those muggy, summer days brought Al and "Q" to their first triathlon on June 6-- the Great Lakes Triathlon Championships in Pinckney, Michigan

"For our first triathlon," quipped Quinn, "we had two primary goals; don't drown and finish."

"We are both a little surprised at the competitive nature of the sport," added Sandifer. "There are a lot of serious triathletes out there, and I think we will take it more seriously after finishing our first one."

Both competed as members of the Gary Gray Physical Therapy Triathlon Team. It was Gray who first approached Sandifer about taking part in a triathlon, and it was Gray who taught Sandifer to swim.

Ironically, it was Sandifer who was the first team Gary Gray triathlete to cross the finish line. He completed the course (1 mile swim, 15 mile bike and 5 mile run) in one hour and forty-one minutes.

Quinn, who came in about twenty minutes later, had this to say about his first triathlon: "When I crossed the line I told myself, 'It's all been worth it.' It was an incredible feeling knowing that I had made it and that I wasn't last."

"Desire and Motivation"

Sandifer and Quinn are busily preparing for their next triathlon and actively recruiting interested athletes.

"We tell people who are curious about competing that if they are a decent athlete; not necessarily a great one, who has desire and motivation, than they can do it." said Sandifer.

Sister Anne Marie Brown, O.P. '40, a longtime employee and friend of the College passed away after a lengthy illness on August 11, 1993.



Sister Anne Marie began teaching in 1950 at Siena Heights. She became a full-time faculty member in 1958 and from 1963 to 1971 she served as the Academic Dean. She then went on to become the Director of Admissions until 1982. Sister Anne Marie fulfilled the role of Administrative Assistant to the Dean of Admissions until she retired at the beginning of August 1993. This past spring she celebrated her 60th year of profession as an Adrian Dominican.

Sister Anne Marie's service to the community totals 36 years, a remarkable period spanning the terms of six College presidents and many pivotal events in the history of the College. She was an extraordinary woman whose life touched all who knew her and she will be greatly missed.
