

Eastern Michigan University and Siena Heights University

Teach-Out Agreement for Students

This teach-out agreement is between Siena Heights University, the teach-out institution, and Eastern Michigan University, the teach-out receiving institution, and applies to the programs listed in Schedule A below.

According to the Higher Learning Commission and the institutions involved in this agreement, Eastern Michigan University agrees to the following stipulations:

1. Accept all transcribed credits earned by Siena Heights students, count those credits toward a degree from Eastern Michigan University (withstanding compatibility with HLC guidelines), and to award a degree to the students participating in the teach-out in approximately the same amount of time the students would have been required to complete at Siena Heights University. Course equivalencies and degree applicability will be done on a case by case basis.
2. Waive the application fee and the Eastern Michigan University residency requirements.
3. Disclose that Siena Heights University students are eligible for Title IV financial aid.
4. Create a financial aid package for Siena Heights University students consistent with that of an incoming student with the appropriate scholarship package for the duration of each student's uninterrupted studies. Siena Heights University students will not pay a cost per credit hour at Eastern Michigan University that is higher than the cost at Siena Heights University.
5. Provide Siena Heights University students with written notification of any applicable fees or charges for Eastern Michigan University and the remaining credit hours necessary for degree completion.
6. Provide Siena Heights University students with resources and support services that were provided at Siena Heights University.
7. Ensure the teach-out institution that Eastern Michigan University is stable and is carrying out its mission and meeting all of its obligations to current students.
8. Eastern Michigan University will permanent house records of Siena Heights University students who officially enroll.
9. Students may be admitted under the terms of this agreement at Eastern Michigan University until August 31, 2027. After that date, Siena Heights University students applying to Eastern Michigan University will need to abide by all policies, procedures, and requirements of Eastern Michigan University. The terms of the teach-out agreement will remain in effect for students who have been admitted under the agreement until individual students either graduate or stop out. Students who stop out may be readmitted under the policies, procedures and requirements of Eastern Michigan University.

This teach-out agreement has been reviewed and agreed to by Siena Heights University, the teach-out institution, and Eastern Michigan University, the teach-out receiving institution, on April 9, 2026.
